



Work Based Activity Instructional Plan for Nurse Aide Students

The following instructional plan is used to ensure students receive proper training in fundamental skills within the Nurse Aide profession while in class and while attending clinicals.

In Class Work Based Activity

During the classroom portion of program, students are taught basic nursing skills and allowed to practice such skills until they are competent. Once the student reaches competency, they are evaluated by the instructor to ensure accuracy of skill.

Evaluations on student performance for skill demonstrations is evaluated by the instructor throughout the classroom duration. The frequency, evaluation, and other notations are available on the skill assessment forms listed below:

Clinical Work Based Activity

During the clinical portion of the program, students are assigned to clinical sites that offer opportunity to implement the course curriculum and offer extended training. A school contract is signed by the school and the clinical site. The contracts are current and state the number of hours, skills, and schedule a student must follow while attending the clinical.
